A Personal Page of Collected Photos & Whimsy, Dedicated To My G.G. Uncle Robin Anderson

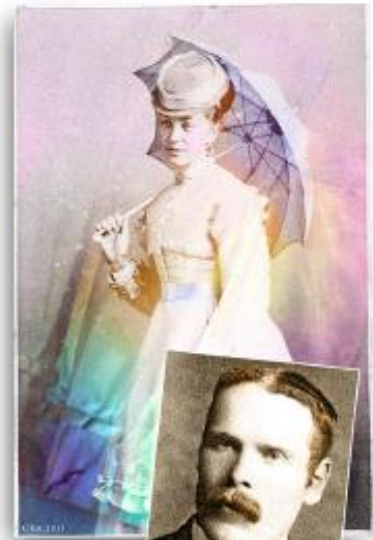


Robert Andrew (Robin) Anderson, was born at Mount Corbitt House, Churchtown, County Cork. He was First Secretary and Chief Organizer of the Irish Cooperative With Sir Horace Plunkett. Robin died on Christmas Day, 1942, in Dublin and is buried at Mount Jerome Cemetery in that city.

So far, no photographs have surfaced of Robin's father, Andrew, nor any of his sister Emily.
